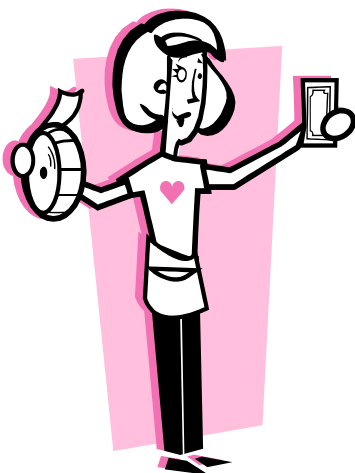
WARRAGUL THEATRE COMPANY ON TOUR!

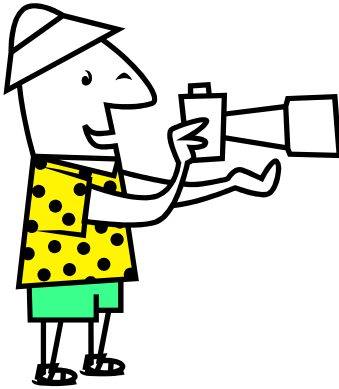
others are being sent out to schools for our images of Annie Art Competition.

Conditions of Entry

All work must be original by exhibitor.
All work must be ready to hang. No entry fee is required.

Closing date for entries is Tuesday 01st May

All works must be delivered to the Arts Centre on the 05th between 2pm and 6pm.

All reasonable care will be taken of art work in our possession, but the artist is responsible for insuring their works against loss or damage. The Exhibitor Committee reserves the right to use any exhibits for promotional purposes. All works entered will be previewed by the selection committee panel. We will endeavour to hang all entered exhibits, however works will be included at the organiser's discretion, depending on suitability and the space available. Each exhibit can only win one prize and the judges decision will be final. All winners will be notified by phone.

All work must be collected by the 27th May. Uncollected art work will be stored by the company at a cost of \$2 per week. All works must reflect the context of the production of Annie.

Prizes

There will be three prize sections. Primary, Secondary and Open. Prizes will be tickets to see ANNIE.
